Dear Anglican School Parents and Guardians:

We write to you at this time, to advise of the Anglican Central Education Authority's (ACEA's) policy changes, as it relates to the payment of school fees.

1. With immediate effect, no student will be permitted to register at an Anglican School, if they have outstanding school fees of any amount.
 - Only students with no balances owing, and whose school fees for the respective period have been paid in full, will be permitted to register for that period.
 - If your child's school fees and any outstanding balances have not been paid in full, they will not appear on a class list.
 - Students are now required to present a fee slip or receipt showing proof of payment at the start of every term.
 - If your child's school fees and any outstanding balances have not been paid in full, they will not appear on a class list.
 - Students are now required to present a fee slip or receipt showing proof of payment at the start of every term.
2. With immediate effect, the existing payment plan is discontinued.
 - It will be replaced with an Advanced Payment Plan (APP). Which means that while payment of school fees in instalments will be allowed, these instalments however must be made in advance of the due date, in order that the school fee requirement is fully satisfied by the due date.
 - The Hilary Term, which begins December 1, 2019, will be the first term for which this plan will be applied.

The operation of a school is a very costly undertaking. To ensure that we are able to provide the quality of education and the kind of learning environment deserving of an Anglican School experience, timely payment of school fees is essential. We must all do our part.

We do thank you for entrusting your children to us and we do also thank you for, your continued efforts to meet your financial commitment to our schools and your continued support, which we value very highly. We thank especially the parents and families that have been with us the longest. While circumstances have dictated that we take these measures, we know that with our collective effort, diligence and support our schools will continue to excel in meeting the needs and aspirations of our students.
